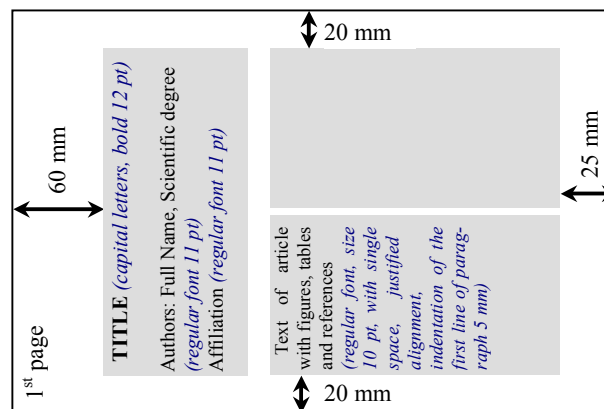
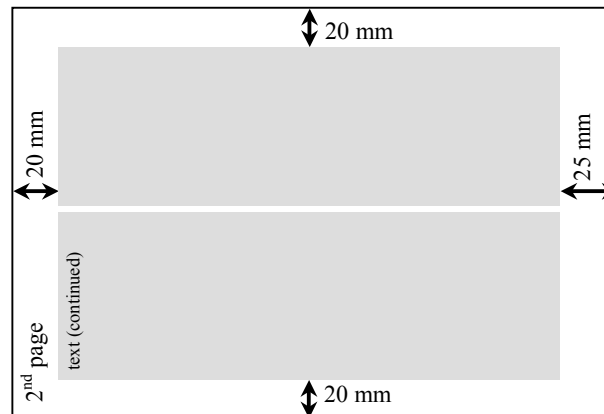

Scope of DAS 2001:

The 19th Danubia-Adria Symposium on Experimental Methods in Solid Mechanics represents a continuation to the series of meetings at the previous DAS Symposia.

The purpose of this meeting is to bring together engineers, researchers, industrial experts as well as students and undergraduates to present and discuss their achievements and developments in the field of experimental methods in solid mechanics.

A presentation of instruments and experimental methods is being planned during the Symposium. Exhibition space will be available and it is anticipated that the Symposium will attract researchers and exhibitors from industry to present their instruments and measuring techniques applied in experimental methods in solid mechanics and related topics. Further information can be obtained from the Secretariat of the Symposium.

Main Subjects:

The organizers welcome contribution within all areas of experimental research and its applications. Particularly in the following main topics:

- New experimental methods and instrumentation
- New applications of experimental methods
- Data acquisition and data processing
- Relations of experimental and numerical results
- Hybrid methods
- Quality and system control

Presentation:

Survey papers and papers invited by Scientific Committee will be presented during plenary sessions, while most papers will be presented during poster presentations, with short oral introduction. Authors will have 30 min (invited papers), 15 min (papers during oral sessions) and 3 min (poster presentation before poster sessions) for presentation. Projectors for slides and transparencies as well as a data beamer will be available. The dimensions of posters should not exceed $W \times H = 80 \times 100$ cm.

Scientific Committee takes the liberty to classify the papers for oral and poster presentations. May we emphasize that from scientific point of view poster presentations are equally estimated as the oral ones.

The official language of the Symposium is English.

The authors of the accepted papers are asked to make a deposit of 70 € as an advanced payment, which reduce the final fee, not later than August 1, 2002. All bank charges must be added to the amount paid. A copy of the transfer should be jointed to the Registration form, which will be sent together with the Second Announcement. All accepted papers for which the authors have made the advanced payment will be published in the Conference Proceedings.
