Scope of DAS 2005

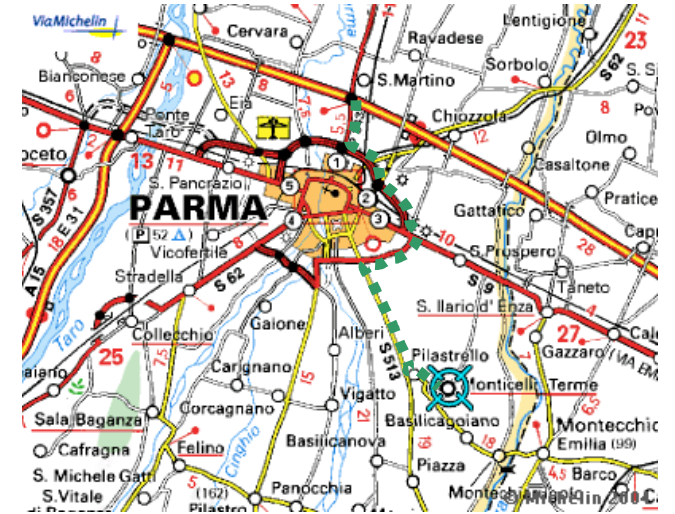
The 22st Danubia-Adria Symposium on Experimental Methods in Solid Mechanics (DAS 2005) is aimed at providing a forum for engineers, researchers, university teachers and students, scientists and industrial experts to present and discuss the current status and impact of modern technology and development in the field of experimental methods in solid mechanics. Focus will be on recent research and development of experimental and hybrid methods for quality enhancing of structures, service life and technical safety.

Conference Venue

The 22nd Danubia-Adria Symposium will take place in the Park of Terme (spa) di Monticelli, only 10 km south of Parma, the city famous all over the world for its cultural and gastronomical tradition. The use of thermal springs in the village of Monticelli dates back to the beginning of the last century, when the park was founded. At present, the Park of Terme di Monticelli includes various facilities, such as

thermal swimming pools, specialized healthcare centres and hotels.

When arriving by car, the nearest A1 motorway exit is Parma. For those travelling by train, bus line 11 connects in about 30 minutes Monticelli Terme to Parma railway station and vice-versa hourly from 7.00AM to 7.00PM (see www.tep.pr.it).

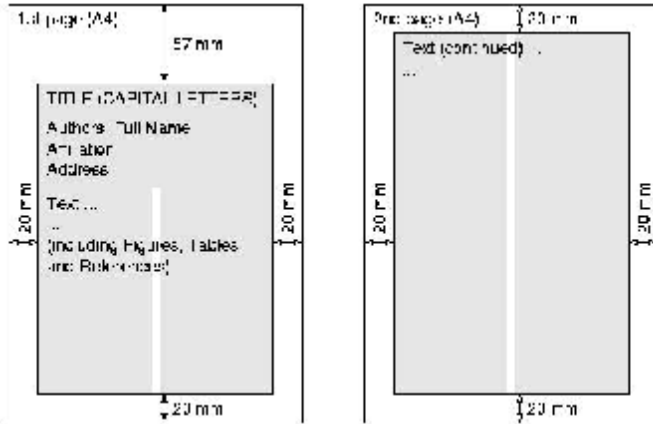
Call for Papers
